

### Second KAS bookletmaker for Ace Graphics

North London based Ace Graphics have purchased their second KAS bookletmaker in three years. The KASfold 3000 bookletmaker with on-line trimmer was installed by Ashgate Automation.

The company, which is run by brothers, Steve and Dave Holyland, has established a reputation in the area for fast turn around, high quality short to medium run digital printing. They also work in conjunction with a local litho printer, offering a full range of services to their customers from concept to finishing.

It's size and performance are ideal for our type of business where some weeks we have several bookletmaking jobs and other weeks, none at all. We also get a much more professional finish using flat staples."*
